



THE SET RESUMES TRADING OF NWR

The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) has temporarily suspended trading in the securities of Nawarat Patanakarn Public Company Limited (NWR) since July 21, 2010 as NWR's request until the process of the capital reduction has been completed because NWR has set the Record Date on July 23, 2010 and the Company's share register book be closed on July 27, 2010, for checking the names of shareholders whose shares will be decreased and who are entitled to have the right to purchase new share, in accordance with Section 225 of the Securities and Exchange Act. The capital reduction, therefore, may affect the number of shares held by each shareholder and the number of shares under the trading system of the SET during the company has not yet registered its capital completely.

Presently, the process of the capital reduction has been completed and the SET has set up the reduction of registered and paid up capital of NWR's securities effective on the trading system since August 3, 2010. Therefore, the SET has resumed trading of NWR's securities effective on the first trading session of August 3, 2010 onwards.

Since the capital reduction of NWR may affect the price of its stocks in the market In order to allow the market mechanism to work properly, the SET will change the daily price limits on NWR securities on August 3, 2010 to 100% of its last trading price.
